Background

About the role

We are looking for an enthusiastic ESG Analyst to support FAIRR's work, primarily on Outreach but also across various workstreams. The role will provide support and coordination for FAIRR's outreach strategy and assist in tailoring our investor communications to a variety of international markets. This is an exciting entry-level opportunity to join an innovative and growing organisation that is working to engage the institutional investor community through cutting-edge research to support the development of a sustainable food system.

The Junior ESG Analyst will have opportunities to work both independently and as part of a team, and fully participate in the activities of a fast-paced work environment, including contributing to calls and meetings with our investor network. They will have the opportunity to represent FAIRR at leading external engagements and conferences in the responsible investment and sustainable development space.

Key tasks

Provide support to FAIRR's existing team and workstreams related to the global food system and our institutional investor network. Specific tasks may include:

- Preparing powerpoint presentations and other related communication tools for investor and company meetings

- Analysis of global institutional investors by country and investment theme to drive tailored outreach messaging
- Analysis of global food, agriculture related trends and synthesizing data for necessary outputs
- Taking call and meeting notes
- Management of FAIRR's CRM system and data entry
- Assisting the team with investor and company queries
- Assisting the team with organising and managing FAIRR events
- Participating in London-based networking events to promote FAIRR with investors and industry peers
- Contributing to FAIRR's long term goal of building a sustainable food system

Required qualifications

- Educated to degree level (or equivalent) in a relevant discipline
- Fluency and experience working with Excel and database management systems like Salesforce. Experience working with Bloomberg would be a value add.
